Since its creation in 1983, AMO (Architects & Site Management) have wanted to promote architecture by showing that it is impossible to disassociate the quality of architecture with the quality of the dialogue between the site management and the architects. It regroups site management in both the public and private sectors, architects as well as managers from the industrial building sector.

In 1984 AMO created the AMO prize for "Architecture and the work place" which rapidly acquired notoriety and became an annual prize. It alternates between the two themes of housing and the work place.
